To continue fulfilling our mission and goals, we have specific parameters around the usage of our studio. We run all public classes and workshops through our booking system and all instructors are paid via a 50% revenue share agreement. We reserve the right to curate offerings and deny any requests to rent space.

Allowable Uses of Studio Space



Public Classes and Workshops

Only Uphora instructors and approved guest instructors may teach classes and workshops that are open to



Private Lessons

Instructors may rent the small studio for 1x1 private lessons. Outside instructors must be approved before booking. Private lessons have a 2student maximum.



Private Group Lessons

a public audience.

10-student maximum. Outside instructors must be approved before booking. Different rental rate applies.



Private Events

We rent the studio for private events such as social gatherings, birthday parties, company functions, etc. where dance instruction is not a feature



Practice

We rent space for private group practices such as performance teams during off hours subject to availability. Practices are not open to the public.



Community Events

At our discretion and subject to availability, we may offer studio space to host community events.
